PALM SUNDAY

When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a colt, it was the first time since raising Lazarus from the dead that he'd come to the city. The story of Lazarus's resurrection had spread so that many regarded Jesus as a celebrity. Everyone wanted to catch a glimpse. They went out to meet him and received him like a King, because they heard he had done this. Jesus said Lazarus's death would end in the faith of many, and in the "glory of God—that the Son of God may be glorified through it" (John 11:4).

As he rode into Jerusalem, the people cried, "Your King is coming!" They praised his victory over Lazarus's death. But the irony was that he wasn't coming to claim his crown on account of Lazarus's death and resurrection, but because of his own at the end of that week. This was the week he would prepare his disciples for a new reality.


