They ask for our prayers in their continued work:

Both Leanne and I are working in a community called La Hamaca. This community suffered from two hurricanes where 50 homes were lost. The community has also been victimized by gang violence. With COVID, many people have lost their jobs. Leanne is working in the training of Trauma healers and I am working with Pastor Angel Mejia in projects of church education, outreach, and youth issues.
