PASTOR OF COMMUNITY LIFE

We are excited that Danny Unterkofler will be preaching this Sunday as our candidate for the position of Pastor of Community Life. Danny will be available to respond to any questions from the congregation immediately following the service. This will be followed by an advisory congregational vote to affirm the Consistory's decision to call him as Pastor of Community Life for CrossPoint. In this position, Danny's role will be to help connect all the people of CrossPoint to opportunities for ministry using their spiritual gifts. He will also be focused on specific ministry to the post-college through age 40 demographic. Danny has completed his Master of Divinity and training to become a Commissioned Pastor. With the congregation's affirmation, the Consistory will move forward to offer an official call, which will allow Danny to undergo an examination by the Classis on March 22, 2022, to be formally approved as a Commissioned Pastor.
