ASSURE PREGNANCY CLINIC

We're grateful to have a representative available from Assure Pregnancy Clinic following our service this morning. Their table will be located outside in the courtyard. Assure is a pregnancy clinic seeking to provide professional advice from people with knowledge of the abortion process as well as options available. Assure does not provide abortions or arrange adoptions, although they can provide resources. They provide a free lab-certified pregnancy test, free professional medical advice, as well as a free ultrasound. It can be a game-changer when a pregnant mother has opportunity to see the child and hear the heartbeat. The Assure Pregnancy Clinic is one of our mission partners. 
