Chapter 23 | Jesus' Ministry Begins by Pastor Don Porter

Jesus is the Messiah you'd never expect. The disciples became increasingly aware that Jesus was indeed their long-expected Messiah, but others were not so sure. The key word in John's gospel is used ninety-eight times; BELIEVE. John the gospel writer wrote so "that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing, you may have life in His name" (John 20:31). John wanted to stress the necessity of an active trust in Jesus, the Son of God. Do you trust Him today?


