he: Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any omfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion Philippians 2:1
he:then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being ne in spirit and of one mind. Philippians 2:2

he: Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others bove yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. Philippians :3-4
