- What really stood out to you in the story of Jesus washing the disciples' feet in John 13?
- Jesus' example of humble service can be challenging for each of us. When you think about humbling serving others, what do you struggle with?
- Jesus was not the only figure in the Bible to humbly serve others. Take a few moments to think of others in the Bible who humbly served others and what can we learn from those examples.
- Jesus washed the feet of some who would betray him. Read Luke 6:27-36 and discuss how Jesus desires us to love others. Try and think of a real-life example where this passage is challenging you in your love for others.
- We have been called, equipped and gifted for works of service. How are you using your gifts to serve others in your spheres of influence? What area in your life currently is the most challenging place for you to exercise your calling and gifts?
