The Story Chapter 5 covers Exodus 19-40, where the people of God receive the ten commandments in a dramatic way. What was true for the Israelites is true for us today; God gives his laws to free us, protect us, and show us love, not to take away our fun and ruin our lives.

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

- 1. You shall have no other gods before me.
- 2. You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them;
- 3. You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.
- 4. Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
 Six days you shall labor and do all your work,
 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God.
- 5. Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.
- 6. You shall not murder.
- 7. You shall not commit adultery.
- 8. You shall not steal.
- 9. You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
- You shall not covet your neighbor's house or anything that belongs to your neighbor.






