- Take some time to reflect on what you know about the life of David. When you think of all the ups and downs of David's life, where do you resonate with him?
- In 2 Samuel 6:5 the Bible tells us that "David and all Israel were celebrating with all their might before the LORD." Yet, in that same moment, they were not moving the ark the way God had commanded. What does this tell us about worship?
- In 2 Samuel 6:13, we learn that David figured out the correct way to move the ark. David was able to repent and learn from his mistakes. Read David's words in Psalm 51 and reflect on what it means to repent and move forward in forgiveness.
- In this passage, David demonstrates what it means to truly celebrate before the LORD. His worship cost him materially and relationally with his wife Michal. What might costly worship mean for you today? For further reflection, read Romans 12:1-2.
- This passage shows David moving the ark of God two different times with two different results. In the end, David learns how to be fully devoted to God and in doing so, the blessing of God is greater than David ever anticipated. Read Psalm 23 and think about how it connects to 2 Samuel 6 and the moving of the ark of God.

Preparing for Communion Next Sunday

We look forward to celebrating communion together next Sunday as the body of Christ. The Bible teaches that we should examine ourselves before we participate in the Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 11:27-29). We should take time to pray and invite the Holy Spirit to convict our hearts and minds, confess our sins, and examine our lives to see if there are relationships that need to be restored.
