Palm Sunday

The next day the great crowd that had come for the festival heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, "Hosanna!" "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Blessed is the king of Israel!" John 12:18

Hosanna simply means "God save us" and that simple prayer echoes across time. Two thousand years later, we shout "Hosanna!" even still. Hosanna all the time. Hosanna everywhere. Hosanna in the highest heaven!


OLD TESTAMENT STUDY



Public Reading of Scripture in the Worship Center


