# Moses: Not Me, Lord! | Exodus 3-4:17

God speaks to us through the call of Moses:

1. You have been created and called for \_\_\_\_\_. Exodus 3:9-10
2. The call of God will often bring a sense of \_\_\_\_\_: Who am I? Exodus 3:11
3. God will tolerate our fears and insecurities but not our \_\_\_\_\_! Exodus 4:13-17
4. The sign of God's presence with you will be His \_\_\_\_\_! Exodus 3:12
